### From the Pastor's Pen

The calendar throws a curveball at us this year. Ash Wednesday falls on February 14th, Valentine's Day. I hope you all remember to send a card, sweets, or flowers to the one you love. I trust you'll remember to come and worship the One who loves you. Our Ash Wednesday services will be at 10:00 am and 6:30 pm. Come and receive the ashes to remind you of your mortality. Come and receive on your forehead the sign of the Cross. Then go and walk more closely with Christ the following six weeks of Lent.

What will you give up for Lent this year? Lent is a time of fasting, when we deny ourselves some of the things we love so that we can give more of our love to Jesus. What is that thing for you? What will you give up for Lent this year? How will you give Jesus more? We'll be holding midweek worship services every Wednesday during Lent, 6:30-7:00 pm in the Sanctuary. I invite you to come and give Jesus your time, your devotion, and your prayers as together we sing the *Holden Evening Prayer*.

Our Sunday sermon series this Lent will focus on prayer, too. I'm calling it 40 Days of Prayer and will be calling the congregation to pray for the Spirit's awakening during the 40 days of Lent. The series will work through the Lord's Prayer, using Luther's Small Catechism as a guide. This Lenten season of preparation is part of a large year of celebration for the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation. I pray that calling us back to our Lutheran roots and the Lord's Prayer will yield fruit this Easter and in the year to come.

But before we get to the fast of Lent, we'll take one more opportunity to feast. Our next congregational meal is on the last Sunday before Lent, February 11th, after the late service in the Family Life Center. That's also the day we'll be welcoming more than a dozen New Members into our church. Come join us for a great time of fellowship, food, and fun!

### The Father Knows Best

9"See, the former things have taken place, and new things I declare; before they spring into being I announce them to you." - Isaiah 42:9

#### Rafiki Foundation, Inc. Dadi Ishimwe Update:

Dear St. John Lutheran Church,

"Earlier this year, you received a note with Dadi's sponsor report regarding the possibility that the Rwandan government might move some children in the Village to foster homes or back to live with their extended families. For some time now, we have been working with the government to see how it might be possible to continue to care for our children. We are glad to tell you that as of this date, only nine children have been moved too far away for a continued connection with our Rafiki Village. Many have been moved to local homes and will continue attending our school as day students. Some remain as residents for now; others will remain as boarding students, spending school breaks with their relatives and guardians.

We thank God that Dadi has been permitted to continue living at the Rafiki Village as a boarding student. The cost of caring for Dadi will not change and we hope that you will continue to support him as you have done in the past.

In all things, we trust God to provide what is best for all of our children. Thank you again for your role in His work in helping African children"
