From the Pastor's Pen

"Continue steadfastly in prayer... At the same time, pray for us, that God may open to us a door for the Word." (Colossians 4:2-3)

The Gospel story begins and ends with prayer. It begins with Jesus praying 40 days in the Wilderness; it ends with Jesus praying for hours in Gethsemane. The Father sent His Son on a mission. Jesus prepared Himself for that mission by prayer, asking His Father for the guidance and strength to accomplish His will.

Jesus sends us with a mission, too: "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them... and teaching them to obey" (Matthew 28:19-20). Like Jesus, we ask for God's strength and guidance in prayer. Our Sunday sermon series is called 40 Days of Prayer. We're taking a close look at the Lord's Prayer and Martin Luther's teaching on it in his Small Catechism. I hope you can join us every Sunday.

I invite you to come every Wednesday, too, for a half-hour of worship with the *Holden Evening Prayer*. This season of Lent is a time of disciplined focus on God. I encourage you to take on a Lenten discipline like prayer, Bible reading, or fasting; and I remind you that coming together regularly with other disciples will keep the spiritual fires burning hot. The whole point of Lent and these **40 Days of Praye**r is to draw closer to the Lord, so that He can put us to greater use.

How can God put you to use in His Kingdom? Who do you know who doesn't know the Lord? More people will come to church Easter Sunday than any other Sunday of the year. We're pulling out all the stops: an Easter Eggstravaganza on Saturday for the family; a pancake breakfast on Sunday; brass and choir in worship; and a sermon that I promise will clearly and powerfully preach the Good News of Jesus' death and Resurrection. If you're looking for a time to invite someone to church, this is it! So who will you invite? Who will you bring with you? Who are you praying for?

The Gospel story begins and ends with prayer. Let this month of March begin and end with prayer, as well.

Pride Comes Before the Fall

"17 You may say to yourself, "My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me." 18 But remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today. 19 If you ever forget the LORD your God and follow other gods and worship and bow down to them, I testify against you today that you will surely be destroyed."

- Deuteronomy 8:17-18a

Have you ever noticed that it is easy to depend on God when you are in a crisis? In fact, going through difficult times often strengthens our faith, as we realize that we are not in control and need help.

Unfortunately, the same is often not true when we experience success. When things go well, we can easily start to think that

it is by our own talent, ability, or expertise. Pride creeps in and before you know it, we forget about seeking God's will and start chasing other "gods" of wealth, recognition, or power. Continuing down this path will lead to failure. This failure can bring us to our knees and turn us back to dependence on the Father.

We should each examine our lives to see if we are using the blessings that God has entrusted us to help others or advance His Kingdom. If not, make changes now to realign your life with God's will.


New Monday Night Men's Bible Study


