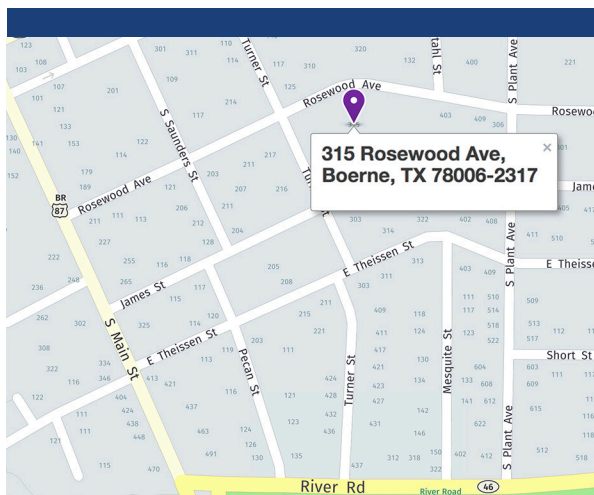
Our committee:
