MESSAGE from the CONGREGATION PRESIDENT

Wow, where did the autumn go? As our calendars turn to Christmas, then New Years, your St John leadership continues to develop our plans for the future. In particular, the Facilities Master Plan update has been top of mind.

In October, we met as a membership to do an assessment of our campus. We gathered after the late service, where our architects led us through a discovery process. In November, the leadership met all day on a Saturday; this time, we developed a consensus on high level direction, and generated

multiple options to consider. Those options were narrowed down to some directions and boundary conditions for the architects.

In January, the leadership will review a draft plan update with the architects. Once we are satisfied, we will bring it to the membership. Watch for announcements on these important milestones.

We are thinking long term. That is our focus. And I am reminded of words from a famous Texan, who led the soldiers at the Battle of San Jacinto. The battle was

fought on April 21, 1836 in what is now Harris County. Sam Houston told the soldiers "be men, be free men, that your children may bless their father's name."

Likewise, we pray that future generations of our St John family will bless their ancestors' names, for the work of those ancestors' hands and minds in 2019. And that they will come to St John with blessings to their heavenly Father's name, for many generations to come.


Happy Hearts January 14th at 6pm
