From the Pastor's Pen

The mission of St. John Lutheran Church is "to know Jesus and make Jesus known." We want to know how well we're doing that, so that we know how we can improve. We need your help.

We're asking the whole congregation to take the **Reveal for Church: Spiritual Life Survey**, and we'd like the whole congregation to take it – everyone who calls St. John Lutheran their church home. The more input we have, the better we can understand where people are in their spiritual life, and what role our church plays in it.

The survey will give a picture of the spiritual life of our congregation by asking about individual spiritual beliefs, practices, and attitudes. It's a comprehensive survey meant to provoke your thought, and will take 15 to 20 minutes to complete. All the survey information is **100% confidential**. Nobody at St. John will ever know individual responses, so please be honest and tell it like it is.

The survey is done completely online. We'll email you a link on **February 9th**, and you'll have two weeks to complete it by **February 24th**. If you don't have a computer at home, or are uncomfortable taking the survey on your own, we'll set up computer stations at church on Sundays with volunteers to help.



We want to understand where you are in your walk with Jesus Christ and how our church can support your spiritual growth. The survey will give us real data about what people in our church believe, practice, and feel so that we can make informed decisions about the effectiveness of our church ministries and programs. Taking the Reveal Survey will be an investment in your spiritual life and in our church.

The mission of our church is "to know Jesus and make Jesus known." Let's find out how we're doing and what we can do better.

And also the blessing of a visit by the homeowner. This is a woman whose life was nearly shattered by the storm. And to make matters worse, she experienced other personal tragedies in the aftermath. But there she was, tears in her eyes, looking at the restoration of her home. The look on her face was priceless, as she saw part of her life being restored. An amazing moment. Make Jesus Known.

Reveal For Church Online Survey: February 10-24

Your spiritual growth is of central importance to our church. Whether you're just starting to explore the Christian faith, or you're a long-time Christ-follower, we want to do everything we can to help you on your spiritual journey.

On February 10th we will be launching an online survey for all those who call St. John their church home. The link to the online survey will be available from February 10th through the 24th, so you can take it when it's convenient for you. Our goal is to better understand what we can do to support your spiritual growth. Here's what you need to know about the survey:

- It's **comprehensive** and thought-provoking.
- You should set aside **15-20 minutes** to take it.
- It's completely **confidential** so you can be open and honest with your feedback.
- You will have to provide some basic information (email, name, etc.) This information will not be used or given out for any other reason. If you don't have an email you can still participate, just ask us how. For those who do not have access to a computer, we will have computers set up at church each Sunday (the 10th, 17th and 24th), along with volunteers than will help walk you through it. **We want everyone to participate, so please ask for help if you need it!**
- It's **crucial**. The findings from this survey will shape the decisions of how we create the best possible ministry strategies to serve you and our church.
