## From the Pastor's Pen

I've always loved Christmas. Even before I came to faith, this was my favorite time of the year. Now that I do believe, I love this season even more. I'm eager to celebrate it with you once again this year.

We start with our Christmas Cantata & Congregational Meal on December 8th. This will be a special time of worship, showcasing the talent of our church musicians and uniting all our musical ensembles in the same worship experience-choir, hand bells, and Praise Band. We'll have two identical worship services that day, at 8:00 and 10:45 (since the Praise Band is performing with the choir and hand bells. there will be no Praise Service that day). Then after the late service we'll

gather in the Family Life

Center for our Congregational
Christmas Meal. It'll be a wonderful
opportunity to gather and worship as a
church family. Put it on your calendar now
and plan to **connect** with your church.
Stop by the Serving Wall and pick up a
card to **serve**.

The week after that comes our **Children's Christmas Program** on December 15th. The 8:00 service will go ahead as usual, but the 9:30 Praise Service will move to the Family Life Center for an acoustic set we're calling "Praise Unplugged." That will free up the Sanctuary for a final rehearsal for the Christmas Program at 10:45. This will

be a youth-led service, our older students leading the liturgy and our younger students presenting the Gospel in the form of a Nativity play. I'm really looking forward to it, both as a pastor and a parent, and hope you can join us for this seasonal **worship** event.

But the highlight of the season for me will be our **Christmas Eve worship services at 4:00pm, 6:00pm, and 8:00pm**. We moved the worship times back an hour this year so that we can reach more people

(attendance trends over the last five years show that most people

prefer to worship earlier in the evening rather than later).
The Praise Band will lead the 4:00 service, the 6:00 service will feature brass and choir, and the 8:00 service soloists, but all three services will follow the same format and focus on carols, candlelight, and Communion. We'll sing

beloved Christmas carols, receive our Lord Jesus in Communion, and sing "Silent Night" by candle light. I'll preach the Good News of great joy that Christ is born. It'll be the highlight of the season for me. I hope you can join us—and bring your family and friends. We expect over 700 people to **worship** with us that night; what great opportunity to **serve** as an Usher, Greeter, or Communion Server.

It's the most wonderful time of the year, the celebration of our Savior's birth. I can't wait to celebrate the season with you once again!
