From the Pastor's Pen

I trust you're enjoying our **20/20 Focus on Faith** series. I know I am. I came to Christ by asking questions about the faith and finding, much to my surprise, that the Church has some very good answers. I've loved struggling with your questions and working hard to come up with clear, concise responses. Three sermons are left in this series. "Can I lose my salvation?" deals with questions about faith as we experience it and doubts about our own faithfulness. "Does finding Jesus mean losing my friends?" deals with the impact our faith has on the people around us. It promises to be a provocative sermon; please pray for me as I write it, and if you're not already on the **Preacher's Prayer Team**, let me know and I'll add you to the list. We wrap things up with the #1 question you asked, "What happens when I die?"

After that comes **Lent**. Lent is the long season of preparation for Easter. It begins on **Ash Wednesday**, which this year falls on February 26th. We start the journey of Lent by remembering that we are dust, and to dust we shall return. Join us on the journey every **Wednesday evening** in Lent as we gather for the Holden Evening Prayer. Once again this year we'll hear members of our church share their testimonies of faith. It was a beautiful,

moving, and well-attended service last year, and this year we're moving it into the Historic Chapel. Mark it on your calendar now and join us. Give some thought, too, to what discipline you'll take on for Lent this year. If you're not already **Walking Daily** with the Lord, Lent is the perfect time to start spending the **First 15** minutes of your day with Him.

This will be my fourth February in Texas, and I'm still not used to it. Up North, February is the month when everybody leaves to get out of cold. Down here, February is in the **peak season** at our church.

This time of year—from January through April—brings the highest attendance at St. John Lutheran. Our numbers always go up for these months, and since last year they've been going up overall. Our average weekly attendance for 2019 was 419 people, and I expect to see more than that in these next few months. People are coming to our church. When you see someone new, take the time to go up and greet them and make them feel welcome. And if someone's in "your seat," just smile and try out someplace new.

Good things are happening at St. John. Keep focused on faith and God will bring the fruit.

MESSAGE from the CONGREGATION PRESIDENT

We have seen it in the news all too frequently. A violent attack in an American house of worship, some right here in Texas. St John members have been asking me recently, if we are doing anything to prepare. The short answer is yes. Let me elaborate.

Last year, a small group formed at St John; we called it the emergency response planning team. We began the careful, thoughtful work of

organizing processes and procedures for an emergency. At the same time, we want to move briskly. Fortunately for St John, a few members with expertise and a servant's heart have stepped up, and our plans are coming together very well. In addition, we have the blessing of assistance from another Boerne church. Furthermore, our Texas legislature has provided churches with the legal boundaries to form response teams.

Although shootings grab the headlines,

a medical emergency is much more likely. Our plans will handle both, and other emergencies, as well. We also are investigating some facilities and equipment improvements. Soon, it will come together, and we will call for volunteers. We pray for wisdom, skill, and willing hearts for this important ministry-protecting God's people.
