From the Pastor's Pen

February is here and Lent is fast approaching. Lent is a somber season of self-reflection and preparation for the joys of Easter. If Easter is the time when we celebrate the new life won for us by Jesus, then Lent is the time when we intentionally turn away from our old life and the ruts we have worn. Many of us will take on a discipline for the six weeks of Lent, often giving up something we love out of a greater love for Jesus. What will you give up this year?

Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday**, February 17, when we'll receive the sign of the Cross in ashes on our foreheads to "remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." We'll have two services at 10am and 7pm, both in the Sanctuary this year due to Covid. Lent continues with midweek worship services each Wednesday at 7pm in the Sanctuary. Once again we'll use the Holden Evening Prayer.

Vicar Alliyah Greaver has written the Sunday sermon series for Lent, called "Refocusing our Life." The series will teach the spiritual disciplines which shift us from living by our own priorities to living by God's priorities. I hope you can join us as we learn the disciplines on Sundays and put them into practice every day of the week.

Speaking of joining, if you've been waiting to join St. John Lutheran, now's the time. Our New Members class will be offered on Sundays in Lent, February 21 through March 28, 9:30am to 10:30am. This is a five-week class designed to introduce you to St. John Lutheran and our picture of a disciple ("Worship Weekly. Walk Daily. Connect Consistently. Serve Monthly."). We'll officially receive you into membership at your usual worship service on Palm Sunday, March 28. I give God thanks that even in this Covid season our church has continued to grow. Finally, I want to let you know about a new opportunity we're offering called "The Leaving a Legacy Seminar." On March 21, 3pm-5pm, we'll host various professionals for a panel discussion and Q&A on how best to leave a positive legacy for your loved ones. Pastor Bergquist and I will be there, as will an estate attorney, financial planner, palliative care doctor, and funeral director. It's still in the works and we'll have more information in next month's newsletter. Save the date on your calendar now.

John 21:15


