From the Pastor's Pen

For the last month we've been looking at the last week of Jesus' life "through the eyes" of the other characters in the story: Caiaphas, Judas, Herod, and Peter. This month we come to that last week, called "Holy Week."

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday on April 10. We'll celebrate with a procession of palms, shouting "Hosanna!" to the Lord who came into Jerusalem as King but was killed "outside the city" (Hebrews 13:12) as a sacrifice. On Maundy Thursday, April 14, we gather in the Sanctuary at 7pm to remember "the night on which He was betrayed." The service begins with a foot washing, continues with a sermon on "the new commandment" (John 13:34. the novum mandatum which gives the day its name), and features a special Communion service with distribution at the altar rail. The service ends with stripping of the altar as symbol of our Lord's abandonment and in preparation for the next day.

The next day, April 15, is **Good Friday**, a day so terrible that only God Himself could make it good, for this is the day Jesus died. We gather for identical services at 12 noon and 7pm to hear and sing the story of our Lord's agony, arrest, trial, crucifixion, and death. This is a sad and sobering service, focused on our sin and the Savior's suffering. But we need to be reminded of the price Jesus

was willing to pay for us so that we can better understand His great love for us. I encourage you to come, "spend an hour with Jesus watching and waiting" (Matthew 26:40) and prepare yourself for the joy of the Resurrection on Sunday.

Saturday was the day Jesus descended to the dead and the day the Apostles rested for the Sabbath. For us, it is day of activity at church and outreach to our community. We're bringing back the **Easter Eggstravaganza** this year! It's a fun morning of games, activities, and food, all leading up to an Easter egg hunt for the kids. The Eggstravaganza is a great "Come to" invite, so seize the opportunity and bring your kids, grandkids, and neighbors to the fun. They'll have a blast!

It all leads up the biggest Sunday of the year: **Easter Sunday**, April 17. Services will be at the usual times of 8am, 9:30am, and 11am, but each will feature special music and all celebrate our Lord's great victory over sin, death, and the grave. This year I'm preaching on Easter through the eyes of Mary Magdalene, who didn't believe—who couldn't believe—until Jesus called her by name. Pray for me, asking the Lord to give me a sermon that will touch people's hearts and open their eyes to His Son!

Reactivity is contagious. It spreads within us as individuals until it becomes unmanageable, and it spreads like wildfire between people. Reactivity keeps us from encountering deep peace and freedom and it causes relational damage and stuck patterns.

But it doesn't have to be this way. With some careful observation, diagnostic tools, and practical habits, you can learn to flip the power dynamic and move from being managed by anxiety to managing it. You can lower reactivity in yourself and others and displace your anxiety with peace. You can be calm, aware, and present.

Anxiety carries a message that keeps you stuck and trapped, but you can learn to notice when you are living by that message of anxiety and replace it with a true belief of freedom and peace through Christ.





changes are coming to our LIVESTREAM

We are upgrading our online streaming services. As you know, we have had some technical issues in the past month with our streaming of the Sunday services. In order to fix the problems, we are changing the way we stream our services.

Beginning April 1, we will no longer be using the BoxCast app. We will be streaming directly to our YouTube channel.

What does this mean to you?

- 1. You can still watch the livestream through our website at www.stjohnlutheran.com/livestream.
- 2. You can go directly to our YouTube Channel and watch the livestream from there: https://www.youtube.com/StJohnLutheranChurchBoerne
- 3. If you are watching the livestream through your smart TV, Roku, Apple TV, or Amazon Fire TV device, instead of using the Boxcast App you will use the YouTube App. You will need to make sure the YouTube App is downloaded, as the BoxCast app will no longer work. Once you have the YouTube app downloaded, you can search for St. John Lutheran Church Boerne. You may want to test this and look now for our YouTube channel before the services this weekend, so you don't miss anything!

GriefShare Support Continues

The Christian-oriented GriefShare bereavement program, under the guidance of Pastor Bergquist, continues and is available to both StJLC members and non-members. Anyone aged 17 and older mourning the death of a loved one is invited to come at any point during the 14-week cycle, as each class is a stand-alone unit. There is no charge for this ministry.
