From the Pastor's Pen

February is a month of new beginnings here at StJLC. It starts on the first Sunday of the month, February 5, when we welcome our fifth graders to their **First Communion**. Jesus gives Himself to us in the bread and wine of the Sacrament, and it will be a joy to watch these students receive Him for the very first time. We receive **New Members** into our church on the second Sunday of the month, February 12. That's Super Bowl Sunday, and we'll celebrate as these newest members join our team and get into the game!

The third Sunday we start a new sermon series called **Unshakable Faith**. Jesus cautions us, "In this world you will have trouble; but take heart, I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). Unshakable Faith is a series about building your life on the Rock of Jesus Christ. We'll see how to face failure, doubt, illness, and uncertainty with faith. The series is based on a book called Unshakable by my pastoral coach, Nelson Searcy. It's an accessible, practical book which equips people to stand strong in faith when things go wrong in life. I wrote the foreword to



this edition. Every family will receive a copy on February 19. We encourage you to bring your family and friends back to receive their own copy on February 26, the final Sunday of the month. That will be our **"Bring a Friend to Church"** day for the Winter. Begin to think and pray now about who you'll invite to church that day.

February 26 is also the first Sunday of Lent. Lent begins on **Ash Wednesday**, February 22. You can come forward and receive the sign of the Cross in ashes on your forehead at two services that day, at 10am and 6:30pm. The sign of the Cross is a sign that you belong to Jesus and have resolved to walk with Him more closely this Lent. Begin thinking and praying now about what you will do to walk with Jesus this Lenten season. **Midweek Lenten services** will begin on March 1. Join us on Wednesday evenings, 6:30pm-7pm in the Sanctuary, for the Holden Evening Prayer and a Lenten sermon series written by Vicar Justin Baker.



NEEDED: Host Homes for the 1st NALC Youth Gathering to be held at St. John on July 1-4, 2024

(Please note that it is not this summer, but NEXT summer.)

We do not want expense to keep any youth away from joining us at this first ever event! There is a potential that NALC students and adults from Canada will want to visit our church. Our goal is to provide host homes and alleviate some of the cost for those who want to attend but need financial help.

Though this event is over a year away, we need to plan now and get a good idea of how many homes might be available within our St. John community. Making these arrangements now allows for pre-planning and advertising.

We will need:

1. **host homes** to be available for overnight guests for 5 nights (Sunday - Thursday).
2. **help in providing breakfast** for 5 mornings. This is a possible request at this point, not set in stone.
3. **transportation** to the church. This would include transportation in the mornings for your group, as well as pick up and return transportation back to the host home after activities have concluded for the day.

The physical, emotional, and spiritual effects
