Read and reflect through these Scriptures on repentance in the church. Revelation 2 and 3 are letters highlighting the strengths and weaknesses of seven different churches—which proves a fruitful way to discern the strengths and weaknesses of ourselves at church and our own church. Consider each of these passages a call to worship more faithfully and use your gifts well for this particular body, that this church may long have a fruitful ministry among its member and outward toward the world. Pray that any sins weighing on the whole congregation come to light that they may be killed.

Let this week's guiding question be:

"In what ways is the Lord calling me to repentance in this church?"

Pray this week:
