From the Pastor's Pen

Lent has started, that 40-day season of fasting and reflection in preparation for the joy and celebration of Easter. What have you given up? I've given up alcohol and sweets, and will be fasting on Fridays. Those three things will be small but continual reminders of how God gave up His Son for me. Giving them up will be a discipline which forces me to focus on Jesus and be intentional of how I live every day for Him. I hope you've taken on a discipline this Lent, too. May God bless us both as we walk with Him these next five weeks.

But Lent is not all about giving up things for God; it's also about giving thanks to Him. Our midweek Lenten services run the five Wednesdays in Lent, starting March 1. We'll gather for a meal in the Family Life Center at 5:30pm, then head to the Sanctuary for worship at 6:30pm. Once again, our service will be the beautiful Holden Evening Prayer, a sung service of prayer and praise and Gospel. But this time, Vicar Justin has written the homily series. It's called Repent! Return to the Lord your God, and promises to be a great series. Vicar Justin will preach, as will Pastor Kurt Wandrey, and Mark Lynn, our Youth Ministry Director. And I'm thrilled to share that Jake Allen will preach too! Jake is a member of the congregation and a Junior at Baylor

University. The Lord is calling Jake into the ministry, and he plans to enter seminary after college. Be sure to come and support Jake on March 8.

Meanwhile, our Unshakable Faith sermon series continues on Sunday mornings, and I'm thrilled to announce another guest preacher—**Michelle Waters** will join me in the pulpit on March 26! We'll do a tag-team sermon together and preach about "Facing Love and Marriage with Faith." It's going to be great fun; I

hope you can join us.

And men, I hope you can join me the day before for our **Men's One-Day Retreat** on Saturday, March 25, 9am–2pm. It's been a few years since our

last men's retreat, but we can't let the women have all the fun now, can we? So we'll gather to share breakfast and lunch, learn practical steps about devotions and discipleship, and spend time in prayer for our families. Look for more information inside.

Lent is here, and let's make it a good one and draw closer to the Lord. Then be sure to mark your calendars for the start of Holy Week on April 2 and the celebration of Easter on April 9.
