## From the Pastor's Pen

May will be a very important month for the future of St. John Lutheran Church. We may meet our next Associate Pastor; we may choose to start a school.

The congregation voted last July to start the process to call a new **Associate Pastor**. The Call Committee thinks we may have found him, and has invited **Pastor Tony D. Ede** to come and visit **May 7**. Pastor Ede will preach at all three services, then will field and answer your questions at a congregational potluck after the Late Service. Mark the date on your calendar, pray for discernment and God's guidance, and come May 7 to meet Pastor Ede, hear him preach, and ask him your questions.

Following Pastor Ede's visit, the Call Committee will meet to decide whether to recommend him to the Council as the final candidate. If so, the Council will then call a Congregational Meeting, at which time the our members will decide whether to extend a call to Pastor Ede. That Congregational Meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 4 after the Late Service in the Sanctuary. Please pencil that onto your calendars.



You will definitely want to ink in another **Congregational Meeting**, this one on **May 21**. This earlier meeting

will be to deliberate and decide whether to **start a school at St. John Lutheran**. Our Council met on April 18 and decided to bring this opportunity to the congregation for a vote. Boerne is blessed with a number of good

Christian preschools and early elementary schools, but that landscape has changed in the last month. Now is the opportune time for St. John to start a school. Tiffany Jureczki, our Children's Ministry Coordinator, has over 15 years of experience running a K-5th grade Christian school and would offer a wealth of knowledge and help this opportunity become a reality. We will hold **Informational Meetings on April 30, May 7, and May 14** at 9:30am and 11am for you to come and learn more. If a school is in the plan, we will need to get the word out quickly, so that parents can register their children for the Fall. Please mark your calendars for one (or more) of these Informational Meetings and put May 21 on your calendar to attend the Congregational Meeting.

May will be an important month for the future of this church. Come and let your voice be heard,

## Meet the Pastoral Candidate: Pastor Tony D. Ede

Pastor Tony D. Ede is a candidate for our Associate Pastor position. He and his family will join us on May 7. His wife is LeAnn, and they have three boys: Carver - 7th grade, Liam - 4th grade, and Burke - 1st grade. All three love football! LeAnn is a middle school Language/Reading/Literature teacher and is a ferocious reader.

He also loves auto racing and going to car shows with his 1979 Dodge Lil Red Express truck. Pastor Ede enjoys playing golf and doing a little hunting and fishing when time allows.

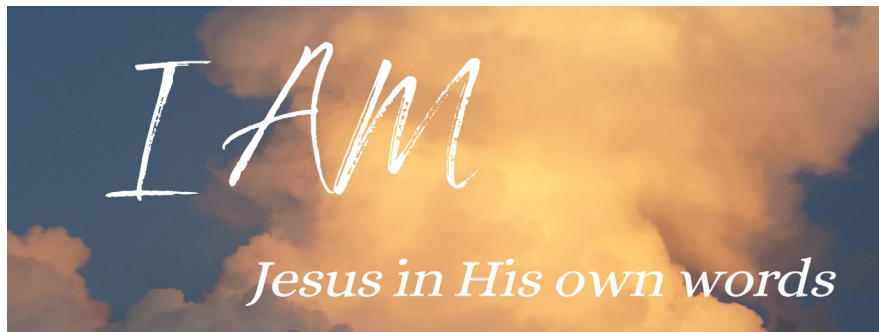
