




Phil Wickam Concert and Dinner





GriefShare is a 14-week program where participants will find support and practical advice Each of the 14 sessions stands alone, and it is not necessary to begin with the very first one.

The recent StJLC GriefShare cycle, under the guidance of Pastor Mariola Bergquist, concluded in May, but the next cycle is scheduled to begin in August.
