From the Pastor's Pen

February is a month of discipleship here at StJLC. It starts February 4 with Walk Thru the Bible: ntLIVE, a fun, creative, energetic, and interactive way to learn and understand the New Testament. The event begins in the morning, when the quest instructor will teach the first session at each of our worship services. Then it continues with lunch and the last two sessions in the afternoon. Do you want to understand the Bible's "big picture?" Do you want to be able to share it with someone in a fun and quick way? Do you know someone who needs to hear and understand the Gospel? Walk Thru the Bible is for you! And it's our "Bring a Friend to Church" day for the Spring. Who will you invite and bring to church on February 4? For more information about Walk Thru the Bible and to sign up, look inside this newsletter.

Everyone who comes will get a 40-day devotional called "God's Grand Story." That devotional will be the basis for the six-week sermon series which begins February 11. I'll kick off the series with a sermon on the Temptation of Christ to prepare us for Lent. Lent itself starts three days later on Ash Wednesday, February 14. The morning worship service will be at 10am in the renovated Historic Chapel, the evening service at 6:30pm in the Sanctuary. At both services we'll mark your forehead with ashes in the sign of the Cross and celebrate Holy

Communion. Ash Wednesday is the first of the 40 days of Lent. Join us as we walk through this season of preparation together.

Then come back the following Wednesday for the first of our midweek Lenten worship services. Once again

this year, we'll sing the Holden
Evening Prayer. This year, our
service will feature a brief
homily based on the reading
of the day from the "God's
Grand Story" devotional book
(we're really going to Walk
Thru the Bible this Lent!). I

hope you can join us - 6:30pm-7pm in the Sanctuary, with dinner in the Family Life Center starting at 5:30pm.

For those of you who have been waiting to join our church, Lent is your time, too. The next New Members class begins Sunday, February 18 and continues each Sunday in Lent. Classes start right after the Late Service and run 12pm-1:30pm with lunch provided. We'll introduce you to our church and our discipleship pathway of Worship Weekly, Walk Daily, Connect Consistently, and Serve Monthly. Look inside this newsletter to learn more and sign up online.

Jesus gave the Church a mission to "Go and make disciples." His Great Commission is our focus this Lent. Come walk through the Bible and through Lent with us!
