## From the Pastor's Pen

March will be a big month at StJLC, so I'm asking you to join me for a **"Sweet Hour of Prayer"** in the Historic Chapel on Wednesday, March 20, 8pm-9pm. Like we have at past Prayer Vigils, I'll write a guide to focus your prayers on events in the world and ministries of the church. Holy Week will start just a few days later; we want to make sure our church is covered in prayer and empowered by the Holy Spirit. No need to sign up. Simply join us in the Chapel that evening.



Holy Week starts on March 24, which is both **Palm Sunday** and **New Member Sunday** this year. First, we'll welcome over 25 New Members at the beginning of the worship service. Then we'll process into the Sanctuary with palms in our hands and "Hosanna!" on our lips. Palm Sunday is always a big day at our church and a good day to invite friends to come hear the salvation story.

Then come back later that week as we somberly reflect on how much that salvation cost. It begins March 28 with **Maundy Thursday**, "the night in which He was betrayed." We'll gather at 6:30pm in the Sanctuary to hear the story of the Last Supper, reenact the washing of the disciples' feet, and gather around the

altar rail for Communion—the only service of the year when the whole congregation is served from the altar. Then the altar will be stripped and we'll leave in silence as a sign that "the hour of darkness has come." The next day, March 29, is **Good Friday**, the day Jesus was crucified.

We'll gather at 12pm in the Historic Chapel and 6:30pm in the Sanctuary to hear Jesus' "Seven Last Words from the Cross" and respond to Him with hymns, prayer, and thanks.

The following day, March 30, is our annual **Easter Eggstravaganza**. This is a great community event! Last year we welcomed over 250 people to our egg hunt, most of whom do not attend our church. Tell your family and friends and invite your grandkids and neighbors. They'll have a fun time and get a great glimpse of our church. Then invite them to come back the next day for **Easter Sunday**, March 31, when I'll preach the good news of Christ's resurrection from the dead and the free gift of eternal life to all who believe in Him.

March will be a big month here at StJLC. Pray that the Lord will work through us to draw people to Jesus. Join me at the "Sweet Hour of Prayer."

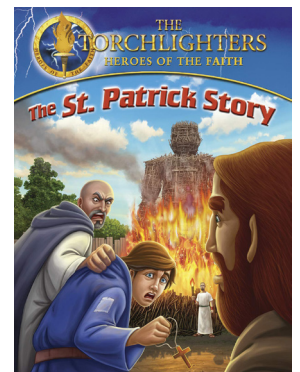

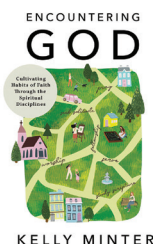

following the loss of a loved one can be devastating. The good news is that grieving folks who find a support group often discover that the process from mourning to joy is possible.

GriefShare is a 14-week program where participants will find support and practical advice. Each of the 14 sessions stands alone, and it is not necessary to begin with the very first one. Participants can start at any point in the cycle.

The current StJLC GriefShare cycle, under the guidance of Pastor Mariola Bergquist, began in January. Registration at [www.griefshare.org](http://www.griefshare.org) is recommended.
