From the Desk of Pastor Eric Waters

Jesus gave the Church on earth a Great Commission to “**Go and make disciples**” (Matthew 28:19). Here at StJLC, we do that by teaching people to Worship Weekly, Walk Daily, Connect Consistently, and Serve Monthly.

September 7 starts a three-year program to help people **Worship Weekly** and **Walk Daily**. It's called **The Gospel Project** and covers the

whole Bible from Genesis to Revelation with a focus on Jesus Christ as the Word-made-flesh revealed in every page of God's Word. **The Gospel Project** aligns the preaching and teaching ministries of our church in age-appropriate ways. The lesson preached from the pulpit on Sunday is the same lesson our Children and Youth will learn in Sunday School. Adults will have the opportunity to dive deeper into that lesson on Wednesday evenings beginning September 10, when the Pastors and Vicar will lead **The Gospel Project** Bible study. Everyone will be given a bookmark to read along with the Sunday lesson as part of their daily devotions. **The Gospel Project** is a tool to get children, youth, and adults on the same page of the Bible so that families are equipped to talk about the faith at home and experience God's story together. I'm really excited about it and hope you can join us for the kick-off on September 7.



That same day we'll introduce our new **pew Bibles**. **The ESV Pew and Worship Bible, Large Print Edition** is a better translation in an easier-to-read font. We want to get people into the Bible in worship and build the church on God's Word. You can be a part of that by donating a pew Bible in honor or memory of someone you love for only \$10. Look for more details inside.

September also brings three opportunities to **Connect Consistently** with our church. Men will have the opportunity to Connect

at the **Men's Breakfast** on Saturday, September 13. Join me for a time of food, friends and fellowship. Women will have the opportunity to Connect at the **Women's 'Faith through the Decades' Lunch** on September 28. All women 8th grade and up are invited to share and listen to each other's faith journey over the last ten years. Finally, if you've been worshipping at StJLC for a while and thought about joining the church, now's the time. Our next **New Member classes** begin September 21. The classes will be offered 9.30am-10.30am and run five weeks through the month of October, leading up to New Member Sunday on October 26. Get excited, everyone! We have a new way to connect... the **StJLC LiNK!**

The church council has approved the development of a congregation-wide program to help us get better acquainted and build relationships. This program will also highlight professional services offered by members.

The result will be an information base that includes members' businesses, vocations, hobbies, sports, personal interests, and more. A hard copy will be kept at the information desk, and it will also be available online through the church portal.

Here's the idea: most people enjoy doing business and sharing hobbies and interests with people they know or people who are like-minded. This new program will make it easier for us to get "plugged in" with one another. For example, you could connect with all the military veterans in church, find a plumber or attorney, or meet someone who shares your interest in horses.

This initiative aims to strengthen personal and professional connections across our 1,140+ member congregation by providing a simple way to connect. Participation is completely voluntary—you don't have to join if you don't want to.

The information base will let members share their talents (e.g. music), skills (e.g. business, profession, or vocation), hobbies (e.g. woodworking), or other interests (e.g. horsemanship). Some identity protection measures will also be included, similar to what we had in the now-retired StJConnect section of our church website.

This program is going to be built entirely by volunteers, not staff. To get started, **we're looking for StJLC members who can help launch this project, especially those with skills in databases, web design, or IT development. We need help to create the means to collect, store, present, and manage the information. 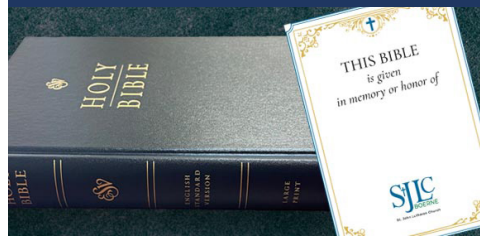

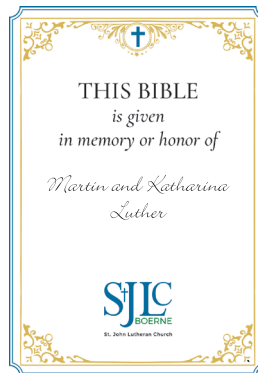
