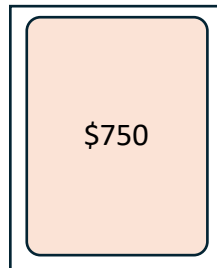
## Advertising Sponsorship Opportunities

### FULL PAGE AD ON THE BACK COVER OF THE PUBLICATION

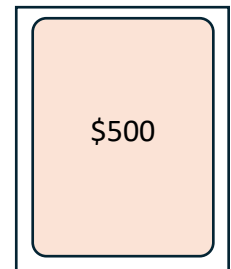
The publication's back cover is the most prominent placement for people to view your Ad.

### FULL PAGE AD

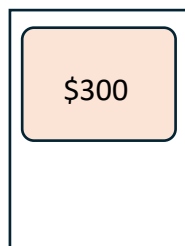
- ✓ A Full-page Ad prominently displayed in the publication.

**Note:** It is important to note that this space will be sold on a first-come basis.

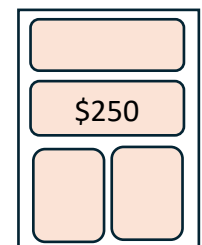
### HALF-PAGE AD

### QUARTER-PAGE AD

### AD GRAPHICAL IMAGE REQUIREMENTS

Please supply the artwork for your ad. It should have a resolution of 300 dpi at the minimum size of the Ad they purchase. For instance, if you buy a full-page Ad, the artwork should be 300 dpi at the 8"x10" or for an equivalent ad space size. Unfortunately, enlargement of an image causes degradation and a loss of quality, so the file should be submitted at the requested size. Files should be submitted as a .pdf, a .jpg, or .eps file.
