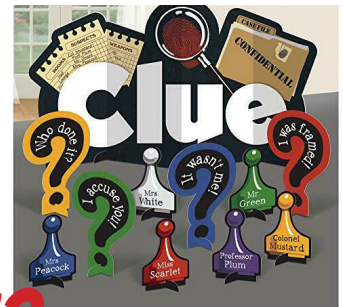

November 25: Load cartons of shoeboxes onto a trailer.

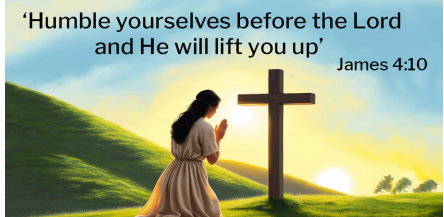
