I remember in elementary school how much fun it was to guess whether March would roar in like a lion or drift out like a lamb. I don't know what the weather will bring this year, but with

Holy Week beginning the first week of April, we will certainly celebrate Jesus, the Lion and the Lamb as March comes to a close. That means the end of the month will be full of meaningful opportunities for fellowship and faith. I'd love to highlight what's ahead.

First, Holy Week:

Palm Sunday, March 29

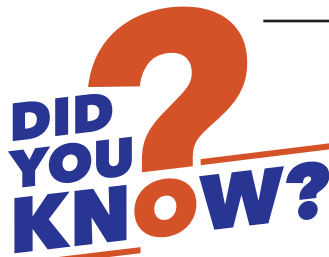
